Certified Phlebotomy Instructor Certification™ (CPI)

The Certified Phlebotomy Instructor Certification™ (CPI) is geared towards an educator who brings a wealth of knowledge and expertise in Phlebotomy practice. The certified individual is considered a subject matter expert with significant teaching experience in Colleges, Training Institutions, Universities, Hospitals, Labs etc.

The certified instructor is skilled in teaching students through theoretical lectures, didactic components, and practical hands-on learning. The Certified Phlebotomy Instructor Certification™ (CPI) increases opportunities and assures your place of employment and students of qualified Phlebotomy Instructors.

The Board of Directors and the Expert Advisory Panel of the Canadian Phlebotomy Technicians Group Inc. evaluates each candidate against a rigorous set of skills and competencies to determine the eligibility for certification and as such the designation is recognized nationally for those wishing to teach Phlebotomy. CPTG Inc. recognizes the need for the Certified Phlebotomy Instructor Certification™ and has voted on the eligibility criteria and program completion of a **Teaching Certificate or Degree program or equivalent** for certification to be granted.

To become certified, you must meet the following conditions:

- Must be a graduate from a recognized Post-Secondary Institution in a Medical Discipline with Phlebotomy training.
- Be a member of CPTG
- Have attained a licence or professional certification within the discipline.
- Have successfully completed a Degree or Certificate in Teaching or equivalent.
- Have attained the Certified Phlebotomy Technician (CPT) designation.
- Have at least 2 years of experience teaching Phlebotomy within the last 5 years in an academic healthcare setting.
- Have a minimum of 2 years of work experience with at least 25 venipuncture and 10 finger sticks (will be verified by employer).

**Members who have attained the CPT (CPTG) credential with at least 1 year of work experience can apply for certification after successful completion of a certificate program in Teaching or equivalent.*

Documents to be provided for certification consideration:

- Copies of your academic credentials, licence or professional certifications earned in a healthcare-related field. For example, RPN, RN, LPN, Medical Technologists, Medical Lab Assistant, Respiratory Therapists, Certified Phlebotomy Technician etc.
- Letters of reference verifying at least 2 years of teaching experience in phlebotomy within the past 5 years.
- Letter of recommendations must be on a company letterhead and provide the start and end dates (if applicable) of your teaching experience. It must also be signed by the appropriate officials.
- Organization verification form will need to be completed by the program manager or program chair of your current employment (**form will be provided via email**)
- Proof of certification in the field of Phlebotomy.
- Proof of program completion in Teaching eg. Degree, Certificate or equivalent.

***ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS MUST BE MET FOR CERTIFICATION TO BE GRANTED**
